Essentials for Growing Healthy Roses

- Provide at least six hours of sunlight a day
- Plant away from trees and the canopies of trees
- Provide for good air circulation
- Plant in raised beds
- Provide adequate moisture/irrigate responsibly
- Use a quality rose soil
- Buy quality plants from a reputable nursery
- Buy rose varieties that grow well in your area
- Use compost during bed preparation and as a soil amendment
- At planting time use expanded shale (one time soil amendment)
- Mulch spring and fall
- Fertilize monthly during the growing season roses are heavy feeders
- Water before and after fertilizing
- Prune after February 14 for beautiful spring bloom
- Deadhead or groom during the growing season at the first five leaflet or seven leaflet
- Control pests be environmentally responsible, Read the label carefully!
